We have recently been rejoicing over some wonderful news concerning one of our faithful Small Group members, Mary Charles. You will recall that her family was featured in our "Special prayer requests" for the month of February & March because she lost her father, Pastor Rene Charles on February 4th. Despite the difficult adjustment of being without her spiritual hero, she answered God's call to go Kampala, Uganda for five weeks to work at "Dwelling Places", a Christian orphanage, with AIM (Africa Inland Mission). Initially Mary needed \$5,600 and now she is trusting the Lord for \$1,400 more in order to be approved for attending orientation & training at the AIM Headquarters in Toronto, Canada. Then the team leaves for Uganda on July 5th. **Pray mightily for Mary to challenge many more Haitian and Evangelical churches in Montreal as well as across Canada for finances & prayer.**

We praise the Lord for having the opportunity to organize and facilitate two seminars in May. The first one was the weekend of May 21-22 with our Friday night Small Group, of which Mary Charles is one of the members. We went to a quaint Bed & Breakfast 1-1/2 hours from Montreal to focus on evangelism, assurance of salvation & doctrinal issues. We had such an encouraging weekend despite all the work that was involved when you have to focus so long and copy notes. Now the Friday night group has written their testimonies, they are memorizing them and they are using them in situations that God presents to them day to day.

Financial Update
