For college students from nationwide, spring break in Panama City Beach, FL means all out partying and drunkenness with no thought of consequences. This is where we took 13 students from Miami on a Mission Trip with 1100 other Campus Crusade students. It was the backdrop of where God radically changed lives.

God moved our students with compassion and love as they interacted with their peers all week. Their eyes were opened to see the disparity between the Christ-centered and rich community of the conference and the Mission Field outside of our hotel. We engaged the Spring Breakers in spiritual conversations and were able to share the gospel with 3,000 people. At the end of 7 days over 600 people prayed to receive Christ in this unexpected environment.



Mark, who grew up in the church his whole life, had his eyes opened to how he was living the comfortable and safe Christian life. He said, **"I've been caught up with myself and have a new passion to share what God has done for us with others and not to keep it to myself."**

Nubia became a Christian this winter and was nervous about coming on this trip because she didn't know how God could use her. When she got there and saw the scene, she remembered doing the same things during her Spring Break trip just 1 year ago. She said, "It feels so long ago that this was me because God has changed my life so much. I remember how I was doing the best I could to find happiness by partying and it didn't work. I know that God can use me because I know exactly how to relate to them."

Most of the 13 we brought are very shy by nature, but they took the initiative to share Christ in the power of the Holy Spirit and left the results to God. They all saw God use them in significant ways in others lives. They came back to campus and organized times for the movement here to go sharing each week! As a result, Nubia and Johnny had someone pray to receive Christ with them at FIU. Praise God!
