At the end of every school year, it's fun to look back and remember what God did in and through the lives of students involved in our ministry. This year was full of truly amazing stories.

This August, the first team to primarily focus on ministering at Florida International University arrived in Miami. God led the two of us and three women from Minnesota and Wisconsin to move to Miami to bring the gospel to one of the least churched cities in the US.



Our ministry teamed with new spiritual life. Students who were already Christians experienced a new zeal.
